
FLYING SITES:-





MIDLANDS KITE FLIERS(M.K.F.)


A fairly new group which has got off to a good start.

Spare PETER POWELL tails?cut up into suitable lengths and sealed at one end
they make ideal kite bags.

Did you know that most spirit based felt tips will write on ripstop.
++++++++++++++++++++++++++++++++++++++
To make it look like you can afford mahogany wingspreaders stain dowell
with shoe polish. To make them waterproof varnish afterwards.
++++++++++++++++++++++++++++++++++++++
Safety pins can be used as a substitute for snap swivels on light line.

Rumour has it that insertion of a heavier line between the kite and flying
line prevents line breakage when a gust of wind makes the kite snatch.
Also you can use this idea at the reel end of the line to achieve the
same result.

Did you know that you can solder plastic together by using a soldering
iron and a piece of paper above the plastic you are welding together:

Crochet twine is usful for flying the light kites as it is handier than
normal line.

have you thought of using velcro when you are kite making, useful for
putting light wind flaps on kites. Can also be used to allow easy removal
of sticks from pockets instead of having to undo the stitching.

Buttons can replace the stop of a ferry.

If you want to paint plastic sleds you can use aerosol spray paint
through a doily to make really wild patterns.
